Happy New Year!! Annual Open Enrollment closed December 7th and the new year is here! Every January through March, is Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment. Those that are in a Medicare Advantage plan get another opportunity to change plans. If for some reason, you missed evaluating your plans prior to the December 7th Open Enrollment deadline, and you are in Medicare Advantage, you get another opportunity. At this time, you can switch from your Medicare Advantage Plan (excluding Medical Savings Accounts, cost plans, and PACE) to another Medicare Advantage Plan, or to Original Medicare with or without a Part D plan. Any changes made are effective the first of the month after the plan gets your requests For example, if you make a change in January, it would likely be effective February 1st. If you are considering a change, make sure you:

- * Find out what plans are available in your area. You can do this by looking in the back of the Medicare & You 2025 book, reviewing plans on medicare.gov or talking to a SHIP counselor.
- * Make sure the plan meets the needs you have. If you are wondering how to pick a plan, we recommend you look at: costs of medications, are your doctors in the network, the maximum out of pocket for health services, then all the extras (hearing, vision, dental, etc).
- Make the change by March 31st. This can also be done on the plan website, on www.medicare.gov, by calling Medicare (1-800-MEDICARE) or working with a SHIP counselor. You can easily reach a SHIP counselor by calling 1-800-390-3330 or visiting with your local SHIP counselor, Rebecca, on the second Wednesday of the month at LCCOA.
